Must have a B211A (C11) Visit Visa for trade exhibition activities.

Must not conduct transactions or work that falls under the permanent workforce category.

X PROHIBITIONS FOR KITAS & APEC CARD HOLDERS IN HANDLING EXHIBITION BOOTHS:

1. KITAS Holders (especially non-workforce)

If the KITAS holder does not have a work permit relevant to exhibition activities (e.g., investor KITAS, family KITAS, student KITAS), they are prohibited from engaging in work activities including booth management.

Legal Basis:

- Law No. 13 of 2003 on Manpower
- Article 42 paragraph (1): "Every foreign worker working in Indonesia must have written permission from the Minister or appointed official."
- Government Regulation No. 34 of 2021 on the Use of Foreign Workers
- Article 4 paragraph (1): "Foreign worker employers must have a Foreign Worker Utilization Plan (RPTKA)..."
- Article 36: "Foreign workers are prohibited from holding positions that are administrative in nature, HRD, or
 jobs that do not require specialized expertise."
- Minister of Manpower Regulation No. 8 of 2021
- Specifies types of positions that may and may not be filled by foreign workers.

Conclusion: If the KITAS is not a work KITAS with RPTKA (Foreign Workforce Working Plan), then booth management activities are considered violations of residence/work permits.

2. APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC) Holders

ABTC only provides visa-free entry facilities for short-term business purposes, such as:

- **Business meetings**
- Meeting with partners
- Contract signing

📌 Legal Basis:

- Minister of Law and Human Rights Regulation No. 26 of 2020 on Visas and Stay Permits:
- ABTC does not include work permits.
- APEC Guidelines (ABTC Operating Framework):
- ABTC does not allow holders to work or engage in activities that directly generate income in the destination country.

Conclusion: ABTC holders are not permitted to actively manage booths or be involved in exhibition operational activities classified as work.

A SANCTIONS:

If foreigners violate residence or work permit provisions:

- Law No. 6 of 2011 on Immigration
- Article 122 letter a: "Any foreigner who misuses or conducts activities not in accordance with the purpose and objective of the stay permit granted to them may be subject to administrative sanctions or deportation.

VOA only for Visitor

visitors attending exhibitions in Indonesia can generally use a Visa on Arrival (VOA) if they meet the specific requirements and their nationality is eligible for the VOA. The VOA is suitable for tourism, social visits, business meetings, or attending conferences, including exhibitions.
